General Rules and Information

1. A membership consists of only those persons living within the same household. The children of divorced parents may be included under either parent's membership providing that they reside in the home of one of the parents.
2. Membership dues are \$35.00 annually, and are due by January 1st of each year.
3. Each active membership shall receive a club newsletter each month.
4. The SRARC regular meetings are on the fourth Monday of each month, except for December in which no meeting is held. Social and sign-in takes place beginning at 6:30 P.M. and the meeting convenes at 7:00.
5. The Board of Directors meet quarterly at time and place to be announced.
6. The club roster shall be revised and published annually in March. Membership updates as published in the newsletter are the responsibility of each member.
7. No member, officer, committee or newsletter editor may make expenditures in excess of \$50.00 without expressed authorization from the Board of Directors. Approval and receipts for miscellaneous items are required for reimbursement..
8. The Treasurer shall deliver a concise report of receipts, disbursements and balances at each meeting.
9. Space will be provided for non-competitive displays at meetings.
10. The monthly door prize drawing shall be held regardless of the number of persons attending the meeting.

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11. Members may place classified ads in the newsletter. The ads are free and limited to twenty (20) words or less. Business card ads are \$5.00 per ad or \$25.00 annually, paid in advance. Non member business card ads are \$50.00 annually, paid in advance.
12. The club library is maintained by the club librarian. The library contains research materials, books, videos and a scrapbook. The club periodically purchases up-to-date books for the library. However, donations and/or loans of materials to the library are welcome. Club members can check out up to two items with the librarian at the monthly club meeting, but must return it at the next monthly club meeting.
13. A suggestion box will be available at the general meetings for members' suggestions, ideas, or complaints. The Board will give all communications serious consideration.
14. Each member is to leave every site looking as good as he/she found it, whether on a club outing or not. All holes must be filled, leveled and any litter he/she has recovered shall be removed and properly disposed of.
15. Any and all items displayed on the competition table shall be properly presented with regard to authenticity and recovery.
