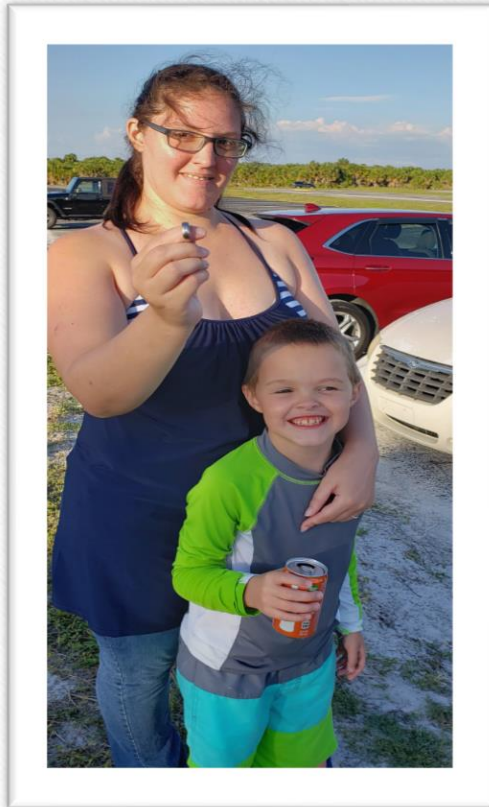
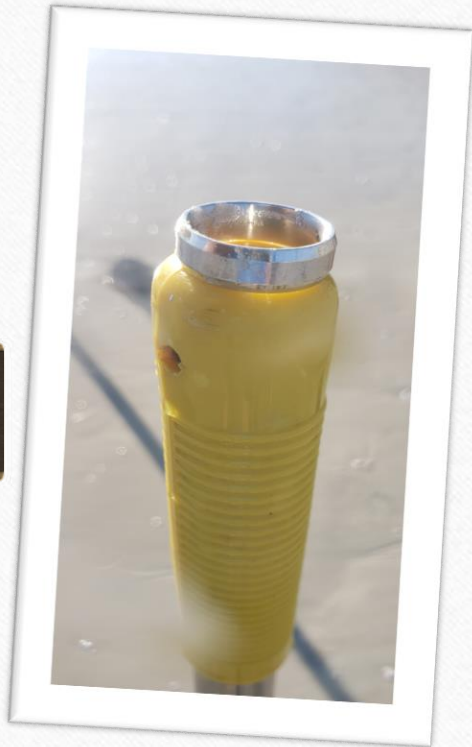




Ringfinders Return!
